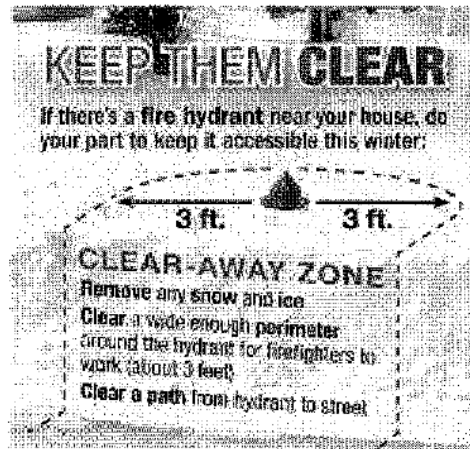


Please help keep fire hydrants clear & visible

During the winter months in Bigfork, heavy snowfall can make it very difficult for firefighters to find and access fire hydrants, and during an emergency every second counts. The Bigfork Fire Department and Bigfork Water and Sewer are asking the community to help keep fire hydrants near your home or business free of snow and ice during the winter months. Please clear a path from the hydrant to the street as well as a 3-foot perimeter around the hydrant. By doing this, you will be helping your community as well as saving fire fighters precious time in the event of a fire.
