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## Project Background

- Constructed in the 1960s
- Asbestos Cement Pipe
- Runs along a narrow corridor of Bigfork Bay
- Access is very limited or impossible
- Sewer Line has numerous "bellies"
- Grease from downtown collects

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## Proposed Changes

- Convert existing gravity line to a pressure system.
- Abandon existing gravity sewer.
- Services West of Electric Avenue will have grinder pumps installed.
- Install a new lift station and standby generator along Bridge Street.
- Replace Sewer Line in Osborn Ave.



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## Proposed Changes

- Service Line Pumps
  - Installed and Paid for by the District
  - Maintained by the Property Owner
  - Connected to the Building's Electrical Service

  - Phase 1 – Spring 2020 (April-May)
  - Phase 2 – Fall 2020 (Sept-Nov)
- Road Closures
- Temporary Gravel Surfaces
- Access Restrictions
